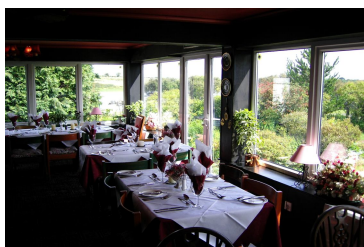


The Golden Lion Inn & Lakeside Restaurant

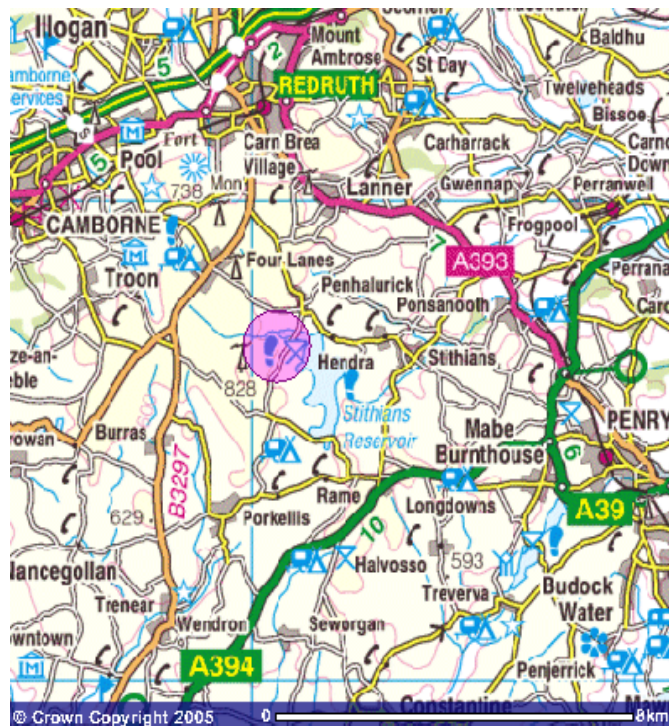

Arrival & Departure

Please Note: We are unable to provide a 24 Hour Reception Facility. All enquiries in person must be made during our normal pub opening times.

On Arrival

We would ask that you arrive with us after midday on the first day of your booking to allow any previous guests to vacate.

The entrance to the camping ground can be found at the end of the car park which is immediately adjacent to the pub building.

Pitches are all numbered and you should proceed to the pitch number which you have been allocated. This will be provided in your letter of confirmation for your booking. If you have not received a letter of confirmation or for any other reason are unsure of your reserved pitch number then please contact us in advance by telephone before arrival, or enquire at the pub during opening hours. Opening Hours are from 12:00 to 15:00 and 18:00 to 23:00.

Once you have settled in, we would be grateful if you could let us know that you have arrived and settle any outstanding fees for your camping booking.

Departure

We would ask that you vacate your pitch by midday following your last booked night with us. If required you may park your caravan/mobile home in our main car park during the afternoon whilst you make the most of your last day! This facility is however subject to availability. Please ensure that all rubbish, personal belongings, pets and children are cleared from the pitch when you leave.

If at any point during your stay you would like to extend your visit, then please let us know as soon as possible so that we may accommodate your request as best we can.

Site Amenities & Facilities

Gardens

You are welcome to explore our gardens and picnic on the benches provided. We would ask however that only food and drink purchased from the pub/restaurant be consumed in these areas during open session times. Thank You.



Water Supply

A standpipe supplying fresh water is located in the centre of the camping ground for your convenience.

Toilets & Showers

There are two toilets and two hot showers for your use which are located on the right of the main pub building (when viewed from the camping ground). These are cleaned daily and are accessed via a code lock system. The code will be provided to you on arrival.

Rubbish Disposal

In order to keep our camping ground clean and aesthetic we would be grateful if you would dispose of your rubbish on a daily basis. Two large waste containers are positioned at the entrance to the pub car park for this purpose. Please do not bury or burn any waste on site.

Things to Do

Our central location in West Cornwall means that you are ideally situated to access all of the best that this part of the country has to offer. Whether you are into adrenaline sports such as surfing, rock climbing, or cycling, or enjoy gentler pursuits such as walking or sunbathing; all are within easy striking distance. Our nearest beaches on the North and South Coasts are only 15 minutes away by car.



Watersports

Stithians Lake Watersports Centre is a short walk from our camping ground and offers equipment hire and qualified instruction for both beginners and those seeking to advance their skills. Sailing, Windsurfing and Kayaking can be enjoyed on one of the most beautiful stretches of water in the South West.



Walking & Bird Watching
Stithians Lake offers easy walks

along its shores in a tranquil setting. Those interested in wildlife will enjoy spotting water fowl of all descriptions, particularly in the natural reserves found at either ends of the lake.

Fishing

Fly fishing permits are available for Stithians Lake, and can be obtained from the Watersports Centre.
