1. MERLOT CARIGNAN **3.00 4.10** 11.95
Cuvee Chante D'Or, France (11.5%, A)
Smooth, mellow, attractive vin de pays

2. SAN PERITO CABERNET MERLOT
Central Valley, Chile (13.5%, B) 12.95
Light, jammy, easy-drinking Cabernet softened with the roundness of Merlot.

Warm & Mellow

3. CABERNET SAUVIGNON
Puente Del Inca, Chile (13.5%, B) **3.20 4.40** 12.95
Super deep blackcurrant-style Cabernet.

4. THE BLACK LABEL **4.10 5.20** 14.95
McGuigan Brothers, Australia (13.5%, C)
Bright red, cheerful juicy aroma, soft sweet fruit and plenty of vitality all through.

5. SHIRAZ 'WEIGHBRIDGE'
Peter Lehmann, Australia (14.5%, C) **4.20 5.40** 15.50
Attractive berry fruit aromas and some spicy, peppery hints.

6. MAZUELO RIOJA CRIANZA
Azabache, Spain (13.5%, C) 18.50
Attractive combination of strawberry fruit and soft oak flavours
Half Bottle 10.50

7. DE BORTOLI PINOT NOIR Vat 10
Yarra Valley, Australia (13.5%, C) **5.20 6.40** 17.95
Intensely concentrated with strawberry and spice flavours with lovely, silky tannins and deliciously ripe fruit. An outstanding Pinot Noir.

Rich and Full-Bodied

8. CHÂTEAU PIERRAIL
Bordeaux Supérieur, France (14.0%, C) 21.95
Smoky dark wine. Carries a forest signature of wild berries and sweetly charred timber.

9. VIÑA CARMEN MERLOT 15.95
Rapel, Chile (14.0%, D)
Dark red/black colour. Gives a nose full of raspberry-edged ripe fruit and a palate full of rich subtle flavour.
Half Bottle 8.95

10. CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 31.95
Chateau des Fines Roches, Rhône (14.0%, D)
The red with everything: deep dark colour; intensely spicy yet floral nose, mouthful of unctuous fruit, citrus zest, spice and candied peel. It finally folds into a velvet finish.

11. CREARO DELLA CONCA D'ORO 29.95
Tommasi, Veneto, Italy (13.5%, D)
Cool ripe blackcurrant style of fruit, oak-aged with elegance and polish. Exceptional style. This is a rare wine using the ancient Oselata grape for authenticity and rustico style.

12. SAUVIGNON BLANC **3.00 4.10** 11.95
Cuvee Chante D'Or, France (11.0%, 2)
Clean, fresh and fruity; a quality dry white vin de pays

13. PETIT CHABLIS 20.95
Domaine Laroche, Burgundy (12.5%, 1)
Pale lemon-green, full rounded aroma and flavour with great finish.
Half Bottle 12.50

14. TOTARA HILL
Marlborough, New Zealand (13%, 1) 16.95
Crisp and herbaceous with ripe tropical notes, and a touch of cut grass

15. BACCHUS
Camel Valley Vineyard, Cornwall (12.5%, 1) 23.95
Light, floral and delicate with apple blossom and a racy edge. A really vibrant dry wine that shows the potential of our Cornish vineyards.

Aromatic and Fruity

16. CHARDONNAY **3.20 4.40** 12.95
Puente Del Inca, Chile (13.5%, 2)
Firm, rounded, good clean modern Chilean Chardonnay.

17. PINOT GRIGIO **3.95 4.95** 13.95
San Antonio, Umbria, Italy (12.0%, 2)
Light and leafy with a hint of pear and blossom. An easygoing match for almost anything.

18. CLOUDY BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC
Marlborough, New Zealand (13.0%, 2) 32.95
This iconic wine is reminiscent of fresh fruit salad—full of ripe peach, mango, and passion fruit, cut through with a citrus whiplash.

Medium to Sweet

19. VIN DE PAYS CHARENTAIS **3.00 4.10** 11.95
Cuvee Chante D'Or, France (11.5%, 3)
Medium bodied, flowery and well-balanced

20. LIEBFRAUMILCH FRANZ REH **3.00 4.10** 11.95
Rhein, Germany (9.5%, 5)
Medium sweet. Nice shape and length.

21. GEWURTZTRAMINER 14.50
Viña Carmen, Chile (13.5%, 3)
Innocent pale gold colour, gives no warning of the high-flying aromatics to follow. Flavours on the palate are both splendid and charming with notes of roses and lychees.
